It is hard to believe - we have been in school for a month now! The excitement of the first days of school has shifted into daily routines. Teachers and students are once again getting into the swing of learning.

We have so many things to be excited about this year. 166 students are enrolled in PK – 8^{th} . 31 new students and 5 new staff have joined Grace Lutheran School. We have a new math series and a new social studies series. Fall sports have started with soccer for PK – 2^{nd} grade and $5^{th}/6^{th}$ grade volleyball. Student council elections have taken place and the student board is excited about organizing different activities for the student body.

We are blessed with an active PTL group that is busy planning events for the school and CDC, plus some joint school/church events. They have already hosted a parent social and later this month, their biggest fundraiser, the Fun Run, will take place. If you would like to help sponsor a child's run, either by lap or flat donation, please contact the school office.

We are still collecting plastic bottle caps in the school lobby. The middle school students are spearheading this recycling activity, with any grants received to benefit their class trip next year. Last year, we received a \$1000 grant. Please help us by collecting and turning in clean, plastic, screw-on bottle caps for this year's collection.

We are still looking for after care staff. Please help spread the word so that we can provide this vital service that so many of our families depend upon! Hours are 3:00 – 5:30 Monday through Friday, although we would be willing to be flexible if someone could not come every day. Please keep praying that God will provide.

LOCAL MISSION ENGAGE CONNECTION

Grace Lutheran has developed a relationship with **McDonnell Elementary School** (4010 Binderton Place Huntsville, AL 35805). We have been advocates for the school and open to responding to needs as they are shared with us. We are still stocking their Lending Library located on campus **but we have a need for children's books, activity books**, basic school supplies and food items. The Lending Library was knocked down and was repaired by us to continue to serving through this place. You can support this project by contributing gently used children's books or providing such items as commercially wrapped individual snacks (examples: Cheez It crackers, Lance sandwich crackers, Rice Krispy or granola bars). Books and school supplies along with food supplies may be placed in the chest in the church narthex. Thanks for your generous support as you respond in the love of Jesus.

First Stop encounters the homeless where they are, connects them to critical services and support, and empowers them toward independent sustainable living. First Stop is located at 2820 Governors Drive. (35805).



First Stop relies on volunteer support to provide hot meals twice a day at our Stokes Street facility.

Volunteer Tips for providing meals:

- Meals should serve 50-80 people. Prepare food for 80 people! 3-4 servers are needed to serve the meal.
- Provide food that is already prepared and only needs to be heated.
 No cooking, please.
- We serve Breakfast and Lunch, Monday through Friday. Breakfast meals are to delivered to First Stop by 7:45 AM and lunch meals by no later than 11:15 AM
- Breakfast is served from 8:30 a.m. to 9:30 a.m.
- Lunch is served from 12 p.m. to 1 p.m.
